Introduction...

**Hebrews 10:26** For if we willfully persist in sin after having received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, 27 but a fearful prospect of judgment, and a fury of fire that will consume the adversaries.

**1 John 3:9** Those who have been born of God do not sin, because God's seed abides in them; they cannot sin, because they have been born of God. **Ephesians 5:5** Be sure of this, that no fornicator or impure person, or one who is greedy (that is, an idolater), has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. **1 Corinthians 6:9** Do you not know that wrongdoers will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived! ...idolaters, ... will inherit the kingdom of God.

**Hebrews 12:4** In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. 6 for the Lord disciplines those whom he loves, and chastises every child whom he accepts." 5 And you have forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as children— "My child, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, or lose heart when you are punished by him; 6 for the Lord disciplines those whom he loves, and chastises every child whom he accepts."

**Hebrews 4:12** Indeed, the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing until it divides soul from spirit, joints from marrow; it is able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
